Each cell of the grid is either a "land" cell or a "water" cell. Fill them all in to solve the puzzle. Each numbered cell is land. For each number, there is one "island" of land cells, though not every island will have a number. Islands are strictly rectangular and may not have multiple numbers. Each land cell is a part of one and only one island; islands cannot overlap, nor can they touch each other except at their corners. All islands must be connected into a single "archipelago", such that all are diagonally contiguous. No 2X2 squares of water or "pools" are allowed.
